Vision #1 - The Man on the Red Horse, v7-17

## v 8 - the myrtle trees

Science: "A well known and beautiful evergreen with dark green, scented leaves, delicate starry white flowers and dark-colored berries, which are eaten." ISBE, vol 3

Hist: Myrtle trees were one of the four trees used in celebrating the Feast of Tabernacles, also called "the feast of ingathering", Exo 23:16. It was 3rd of the great annual feasts, Lev 23:33-43. It was celebrated immediately after the harvest in the seventh month of the sacred year, Tisri.

They celebrated for 8 days, living in booths formed of 4 tree branches: palm, willow, myrtle, cedar. Numbers 29 ordains the sacrifices to be offered.

Solomon's Temple was dedicated at this feast, 1 Kings 8.

Nehemiah 8 notes the celebration of this feast after the Captivity.

The feast was: (1) a memorial of the wilderness wanderings, & (2) a harvest thanksgiving.

- were in the bottom Spir: Israel was no longer 'the head' Deu 28:13.
- a man ... red horse Isaiah 63:1-4

red is a fiery color - He is jealous for Jerusalem, v 14. And angry at her enemies

v 9 angel ... talked with me This 'angel' is an OT appearance of the Lord v10 = v11 { Hist / Doct: Angels help Israel - Daniel 8:16 12:1 }

v 11 walk ... through the earth, i.e. the horses, v 8 Doct: **Joel 2:4** (v 1 - 10)

Spir: James 3:3

sitteth still ... at rest. Doct: Isaiah 14:1-7

v 12 indignation ... 70 years Hist: the Babylonian Captivity of Jeremiah 25:11 (29:10)

v 13 good words and comfortable words Hist: Jeremiah 29:10-11 Spir: 1 Timothy 4:6

Doct: Jeremiah 30:11 & Revelation 21:1-5

Vision # 2 - The 4 Horns & the 4 Carpenters, v 18 - 21

v 18-19 behold four horns

A 'horn' is a symbol of a Gentile king, Daniel 7:24.

Hist/Doct: These 4 horns represent the 4 world empires of Daniel chapters 2 & 7.

v 20 four 'carpenters' - first six ref = 2 Sam 5:11, 2 K12:11 & 22:6, 1 Ch 14:1, 2 Ch 24:12, Ezra 3:7 'carpenters' - all were used to build the Lord's temple.

OT Hist: = Zerubbabel, Jeshua, Haggai, Zechariah Ezra 5:1-2

NT Spir: = apostles, prophets, evangelists, pastors **Ephesians 4:11**
