JOB, HOW ARE YOU FEELING? 1/2/2022 Message #1 Handling Stress Biblically Text: Job

Theme: Learning not to add to the stress of those in trials.

What is the one point I am trying to get across? We often make peoples' trials more difficult by what we say to them as family and friends

Job was a man of integrity and wealth. While he lost his wealth he never lost his integrity (Job 1:1, 22; 2:3)

Sadly one of Job's greatest tests was responding to his friends who were trying to help him (2:11-13)

Outline of Job

Job's dilemma (1-3) Job's debates/dialogs (4-37) 3 debates w/ 3 friends 4 speeches Job's deliverance (38-42)

Notice how difficult it was for Job after hearing his friends' comments (12:2, 3; 16:1-3; 19:1, 2; 21:3) The Lord also challenged the three friends (42:7)

Have you ever not wanted to come to Church or not wanted to let people know just because of all of the questions?

What should we say or do? Reassure them of your prayers and concern If you are close, offer them to talk later Ask them if there is a passage or characteristic about God that has been helpful
