THE NIV'S FIRST HERESY IN MICAH 5:2

The New International Version makes two significant changes, because of the false Hebrew text and false Hebrew words. The King James Bible is based on the proper Hebrew. It says, speaking of the Lord Jesus Christ, "whose goings forth have been from of old, from everlasting." In other words, He was always from everlasting to everlasting. He had no beginning. He was from eternity past to eternity future. That speaks of the Lord Jesus Christ. What does the NIV say? Not "whose goings forth," but "whose origins." That means the Lord Jesus Christ had a beginning! That is pure heresy! When Haddon Heights Baptist Church had a Christmas play many years ago, they quoted the NIV and they quoted this verse. Afterwards, I went to the pastor and said, "Pastor, that is heresy! You say the Lord Jesus Christ had *origins*!" They had the wrong translation right there in the church where we were members.
