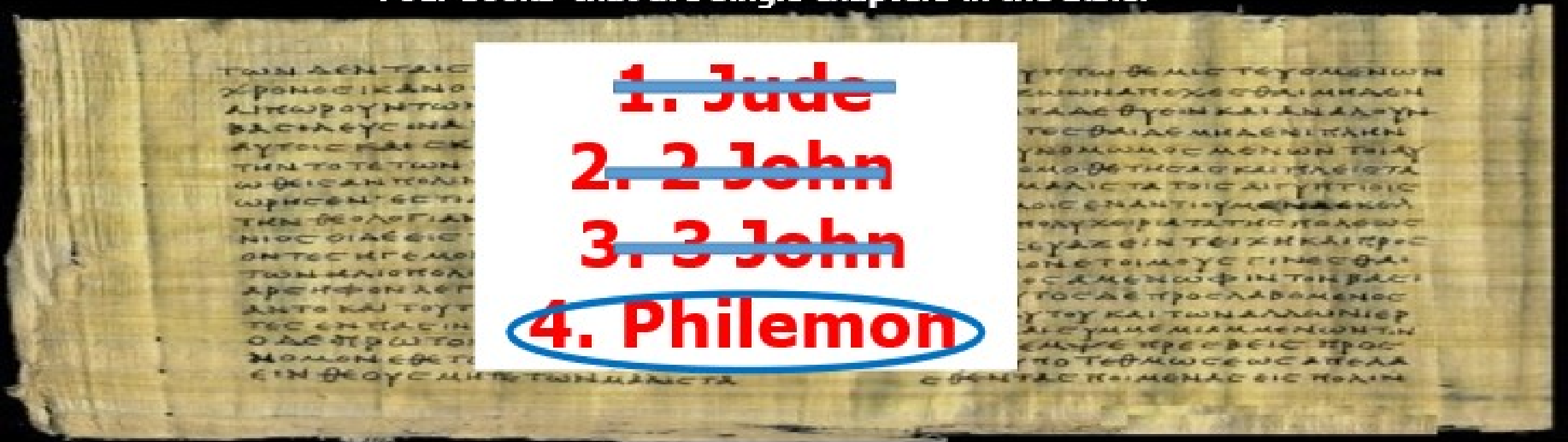

Paul, under house arrest for 2 years, writes to the churches at Colossae, Ephesus, and Philippi.

Philemon receives a personal letter from Paul.

PHILEMON

- **Philemon** --- Friendly
- **Onesimus** --- Profitable, Useful
- **Paul** --- Small, Little

Setting/Time

Written between **60-64 AD** during Paul's Roman imprisonment after his missionary journey's..

Sent back to Colossae with **Tychius** and **Philemon**,

Col 4:7-9..

PHILEMON'S COMMITMENTS

1. Philemon was so committed to Christ that he was counted **"beloved"** by Paul himself.
2. Philemon was so committed to Christ that he was a laborer for Christ.
3. Philemon was so committed to Christ that he rooted his family in Christ.
4. Philemon was so committed to Christ that he opened his home to the church.

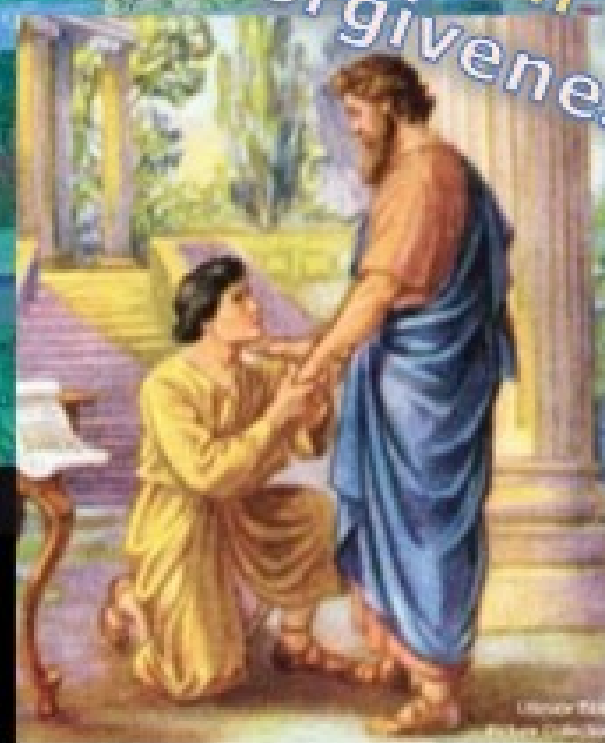


The First Lesson Paul gives us is...
