
OVERCOMING LITTLE THINGS!

(JOEY FAUST, 1-2-22)



TEXT: Galatians 5:8 This persuasion cometh not of him that calleth you. 9 A little leaven leaveneth the whole lump.

Matthew 16:12 Then understood they how that he bade them not beware of the leaven of bread, but of the doctrine of the Pharisees and of the Sadducees.

2 Corinthians 6:17 Wherefore come out from among them, and be ye separate, saith the Lord, and touch not the unclean thing; and I will receive you,

2 Kings 5:19 And he said unto him, Go in peace. So he departed from him a little way.

2 Kings 5:20 But Gehazi, the servant of Elisha the man of God, said, Behold, my master hath spared Naaman this Syrian, in not receiving at his hands that which he brought: but as the LORD liveth, I will run after him, and take somewhat of him.

2 Kings 5:21 So Gehazi followed after Naaman. And when Naaman saw him running after him, he lighted down from the chariot...

2 Kings 5:27 The leprosy therefore of Naaman shall cleave unto thee, and unto thy seed for ever. And he went out from his presence a leper as white as snow.

Ecclesiastes 10:1 Dead flies cause the ointment of the apothecary to send forth a stinking savour: so doth a little folly him that is in reputation for wisdom and honour.

Proverbs 4:23 Keep thy heart with all diligence; for out of it are the issues of life.

James 3:6 And the tongue is a fire, a world of iniquity: so is the tongue among our members, that it defileth the whole body, and setteth on fire the course of nature; and it is set on fire of hell.

1 Corinthians 5:6 Your glorying is not good. Know ye not that a little leaven leaveneth the whole lump? 13...Therefore put away from among yourselves that wicked person.

Ecclesiastes 9:18...one sinner destroyeth much good.

Song of Solomon 2:15 Take us the foxes, the little foxes, that spoil the vines: for our vines have tender grapes.



Song of Solomon 4:12 A garden inclosed is my sister, my spouse; a spring shut up, a fountain sealed.

2 Timothy 3:5 Having a form of godliness, but denying the power thereof: from such turn away. 6 For of this sort are they which creep into houses...

- Genesis 19:18 And Lot said unto them, Oh, not so, my Lord:
- 19...I cannot escape to the mountain, lest some evil take me, and I die:
- 20 Behold now, this city is near to flee unto, and it is a little one: Oh, let me escape thither, (is it not a little
- one?) and my soul shall live.
- 22 Haste thee, escape thither; for I cannot do any thing till thou be come thither. Therefore the name of
- the city was called **Zoar**.

Genesis 19:24 Then the LORD rained upon Sodom and upon Gomorrah brimstone and fire from the LORD out of heaven; 26 But his wife looked back from behind him, and she became a pillar of salt. 30 And Lot went up out of Zoar, and dwelt in the mountain, and his two daughters with him; for he feared to dwell in Zoar...

Proverbs 6:6 Go to the ant, thou sluggard; consider her ways, and be wise: 10 Yet a little sleep, a little slumber, a little folding of the hands to sleep:

Proverbs 30:24 There be four things which are little upon the earth, but they are exceeding wise: 25 The ants are a people not strong, yet they prepare their meat in the summer;

Isaiah 28:9 Whom shall he teach knowledge? and whom shall he make to understand doctrine? them that are weaned from the milk, and drawn from the breasts. 10 For precept must be upon precept, precept upon precept; line upon line, line upon line; here a little, and there a little:

Psalms 131:1 LORD, my heart is not haughty, nor mine eyes lofty: neither do I exercise myself in great matters, or in things too high for me. 2 Surely I have behaved and quieted myself, as a child that is weaned of his mother: my soul is even as a weaned child.

Haggai 1:4 Is it time for you, O ye, to dwell in your cieled houses, and this house lie waste?
6 Ye have sown much, and bring in little...
7 Thus saith the LORD of hosts; Consider your

ways.

8 Go up to the mountain, and bring wood, and build the house; and I will take pleasure in it, and I will be glorified, saith the LORD.

9 Ye looked for much, and, lo, it came to little; and when ye brought it home, I did blow upon it. Why? saith the LORD of hosts. Because of mine house that is waste, and ye run every man unto his own house.

Zechariah 4:10 For who hath despised the day of small things?...

Proverbs 24:10 If thou faint in the day of adversity, thy strength is small.

Job 4:3 Behold, thou hast instructed many... 5 But now it is come upon thee, and thou faintest; it toucheth thee, and thou art troubled.

Matthew 16:26 For what is a man profited, if he shall gain the whole world, and lose his own soul? or what shall a man give in exchange for his soul?

Luke 19:17 And he said unto him, Well, thou good servant: because thou hast been faithful in a very little, have thou authority over ten cities.

Matthew 25:21 His lord said unto him, Well done, thou good and faithful servant: thou hast been faithful over a few things, I will make thee ruler over many things: enter thou into the joy of thy lord.

2 Corinthians 4:17 For our light affliction, which is but for a moment, worketh for us a far more exceeding and eternal weight of glory;

Job 14:1 Man that is born of a woman is of few days, and full of trouble.

Hebrews 11:25 Choosing rather to suffer affliction with the people of God, than to enjoy the pleasures of sin for a season;

1 Peter 4:7 But the end of all things is at hand: be ye therefore sober, and watch unto prayer.

Job 24:13 They are of those that rebel against the light...

24 They are exalted for a little while,

but are gone and brought low; they are taken out of the way as all other, and cut off as the tops of the ears of corn. Job 20:4 Knowest thou not this of old, since man was placed upon earth,

5 That the triumphing of the wicked is short, and the joy of the hypocrite but for a moment?
6 Though his excellency mount up to the heavens, and his head reach unto the clouds;
7 Yet he shall perish for ever like his own dung: they which have seen him shall say, Where is he? Isaiah 10:25 For yet a very little while, and the indignation shall cease, and mine anger in their destruction.

Psalms 37:1 Fret not thyself because of evildoers, neither be thou envious against the workers of iniquity.

2 For they shall soon be cut down like the grass, and wither as the green herb.4 Delight thyself also in the LORD; and he shall give thee the desires of thine heart.

10 For yet a little while, and the wicked shall not be: yea, thou shalt diligently consider his place, and it shall not be. 13 The Lord shall laugh at him: for he seeth that his day is coming. 16 A little that a righteous man hath is better than the riches of many wicked.

Proverbs 15:16 Better is little with the fear of the LORD than great treasure and trouble therewith.

Proverbs 16:8 Better is a little with righteousness than great revenues without right.

Hebrews 10:37 For yet a little while, and he that shall come will come, and will not tarry.

- Isaiah 54:7 For a small moment have I forsaken thee; but with great mercies will I gather thee. 8 In a <u>little</u> wrath I hid my face from thee for a moment; but with everlasting kindness will I have mercy on thee, saith the LORD thy Redeemer.
- 17...and every tongue that shall rise against thee in judgment thou shalt condemn. This is the heritage of the servants of the LORD...

- Luke 14:18 And they all with one consent began to make excuse. The first said unto him, I have bought a piece of ground, and I must needs go and see it: I pray thee have me excused.
- 19 And another said, I have bought five yoke of oxen, and I go to prove them: I pray thee have me excused.

Matthew 22:5 But they made light of it, and went their ways, one to his farm, another to his merchandise: Luke 8:14 And that which fell among thorns are they, which, when they have heard, go forth, and are choked with cares and riches and pleasures of this life, and bring no fruit to perfection.

Hebrews 12:16 Lest there be any fornicator, or profane person, as Esau, who for one morsel of meat sold his birthright.

Luke 21:34 And take heed to yourselves, lest at any time your hearts be overcharged with surfeiting, and drunkenness, and cares of this life, and so that day come upon you unawares.

- Matthew 6:31 Therefore take no thought, saying, What shall we eat? or, What shall we drink? or, Wherewithal shall we be clothed? **32** (For after all these things do the Gentiles seek:) for your heavenly Father knoweth that ye have need of all these things. 33 But seek ye first the kingdom of God, and his righteousness; and all these things shall be added
- unto you.

Esther 3:1 After these things did king Ahasuerus promote Haman...and advanced him, and set his seat above all the princes that were with him. 5 And when Haman saw that Mordecai bowed not, nor did him reverence, then was Haman full of wrath.

Esther 5:12 Haman said moreover, Yea, Esther the queen did let no man come in with the king unto the banquet that she had prepared but myself; and to morrow am I invited unto her also with the king. 13 Yet all this availeth me nothing, so long as I see Mordecai the Jew sitting at the king's gate.
