- **II.** Location Church Fellowship Hall (Classes will be audio-recorded)
- **III. Purpose** Our starting goal in this class is six-fold:
 - A) To give you a greater love and appreciation for the rich history of Christ's church and for those who have given their lives for the sake of the gospel of Christ;
 - B) To teach both men and women to have a clear understanding of what it means to be a true Biblical servant;
 - C) To learn to apply the God-given roles in the home and the local church;
 - D) To encourage you to become more like Jesus Christ in every area of your life;
 - E) To help prepare you for whatever service the Lord has in store for you in the church;
 - F) To exhort you when it comes to putting self to death and learning how to put off the old man and put on the new man in Christ Jesus.

IV. Participation

- A. Learning is hard. The apostle Paul reminds us in 1 Cor. 9:27 -- But I discipline my body and keep it under control, lest after preaching to others I myself should be disqualified. While this will not be easy, it will be profitable for your learning and for the glory of Christ.
- B. Requires active participation for successful completion. This includes involvement in the Biblical Doctrine Class on Sunday evenings. While active attendance is greatly encouraged, you will be able to listen online as well.
- C. Taking time to do additional assignments will be to your benefit.
- D. Prayerfully purchase each book and consider it as an investment. If you struggle with finances where you cannot purchase a particular book, please let Pastor Mark know as some funds have been made available. Do not let a need stand in the way of gaining Biblical knowledge. However, many books can also be found used at great discounts at Ebay.com, Half.com, or Thriftbooks.com.

- E. Hold yourself accountable with another brother or sister in the church.
 - a. Don't all pick the same person.
 - b. Brothers pick brothers and sisters pick sisters.
 - c. Be honest about your time and what you are learning.
 - d. Be gracious with one another as Christ is with you.
 - e. Learn about your accountability partner.
- F. Bible reading and time with the Lord will be a necessity, but we will provide tools that will help you accomplish this.
