The personality of God

- God is not an impersonal force, but a caring God who possesses attributes of personality
- Psalm 103:8-14

Zechariah 12:1

"...the LORD, which stretcheth forth the heavens, and layeth the foundation of the earth, and formeth the spirit of man within him."

The Doctrine of God

The Attributes of God

- The Natural attributes (only God possess)
- The Moral attributes (He tells us to emulate)

The Natural Attributes of God

Omniscience—God is all-knowing

Omnipotence—God is all-powerful



Psalm 8:3-4 *“When I consider thy heavens, the work of thy fingers, the moon and the stars, which thou hast ordained; What is man, that thou art mindful of him?”*

The Natural Attributes of God

Omniscience—God is all-knowing

Omnipotence—God is all-powerful

Omnipresence—God is present everywhere

Eternality—God always exists

Immutability—God is always the same

Sovereign—God has complete authority

Application:

God knows what is best for us, and has the power, authority and wisdom to perform His will in our lives. We need to trust in Him
