6. Why did God command the people to build the Tabernacle (25:8)?
7. What very important instruction did God give to Moses about the building of the Tabernacle (25:9)?
8. What set off the Tabernacle from everything else around it (26:1a)?
9. Of what kind of material were these items to be made (26:1b)?
10. What image was to be worked into the curtains (26:1b)? What were these? What might be a reason for their being woven into the curtains?
11. How were the curtains joined together (26:3-6a)?
12. Why were the curtains tied together (26:6b)?
13. Why might the LORD God have preserved the plans for the construction of a structure that is no longer used or needed?
14. What features of the construction of the Tabernacle stand out to you?
15. What does the Tabernacle construction reveal about God's "priorities" for His people?
16. What truths about God's design for the people's giving and contributing to the construction of the Tabernacle do you think apply to your life with God in this era?
17. How does God dwell with people today?
18. How was the Tabernacle special? How was the Tabernacle similar to other buildings of the day?
19. How does the Tabernacle reveal Christ?
20. How was the incarnation of Christ a "Tabernacle"?
