- 1. Secular religions (atheism, agnosticism, secular humanism, naturalism, etc.) have reached a unique status in the West today. (Psalm 53:1)
- 2. The 1800's brought about an explosion of these religions in various forms.
- 3. For example: Charles Lyell 1830's (geological evolution or "millions of years") and Charles Darwin 1859 (biological evolution from a common ancestor)
- 4. We see the fruit of these religious views in our culture today and it is growing.
- 5. They are dominating areas of life and culture such as: media, education, law, museums, sexual expression and the minds of the next generation.
- 6. Churches in the West who for years have sent missionaries out to the field are now crumbling at a foundational level due in part to the influence of secularism.
- 7. Many secularists live their lives borrowing from God's Word even though they fail to realize it.
- 8. So if people are merely evolved creatures and there is no God who sets right and wrong then why wear clothes, why get married, or why bother with education at all, etc.
- 9. Tolerance of every religion is not the same as "accepting every religion as true."
- 10. So how does the Bible view other religions?
- 11. Religious consciousness is a product of two things: (Romans 1:18-20)
  - A. God's revelation
  - B. Suppression of that revelation
- 12. Misdirected religion is an idolatrous response to God's revelation. (1 Peter 3:13-17)
- 13. When we give a defense or reason for the "hope" that is in us we have to remember that our hope is in the person and work of Jesus Christ.
- 14. It has been noted that all the other religions in the world are based on what a person must do to achieve the ultimate state while Christianity is a religion that is based on what has been done for us in Jesus Christ.
- 15. Do not be intimidated or afraid to use your Bible.
- 16. Let Scripture speak to the authority of the God of the universe who created all things and rules over all things.
- 17. In Proverbs 26:4-5 we are given a strategy for dealing with those who are foolishly denying God's existence or pursuing false gods to serve and worship.
- 18. The issue is the foundation upon which their religious belief system is built. (Ephesians 2:19-22)

## **Conclusion**:

- So all of the religions apart from Christianity are divided as follows:
- A. <u>Counterfeits of Christianity</u> religions that look or act much like Christianity but deviate from the truth in some way, like Mormonism, Islam, Satanism, etc.
- B. <u>Moralistic Religions</u> religions that teach a moral code that have no god like Buddhism or Confucianism or if they do have "gods" they are only slightly above humanity like some forms of paganism and mythologies.
- C. Mystical Religions Eastern thought like Hinduism, Taoism, Sikhism, or New Age.
- D. <u>Materialistic/Atheistic Religions</u> Secular humanism, atheism, agnosticism, hedonism, Epicureanism, etc.
