INTRODUCTION

1. Jesus is God the Son incarnate. The 1 true God is triune. Jesus is one divine person in 2 natures: the Son who is the God-Man. We look at Jesus & exclaim

w/ Thomas: My Lord & my God! [Jn 20:28].

2. Xmas - <u>Jn 1:1-3</u> [SS]; <u>1:14</u> [AM] & now - <u>v18</u>.

1st: The Only-Begotten Son in Relation to the Father

- No one has seen God at any time but what about Moses? Ex 33:11; Num 12:8. Moses asked to see God's glory <u>Dt 33:20</u> can't see face, would die; <u>v23</u>. Samon's parents [Jdg 13:21-22]; Isaiah Isa 6:5
- 2. No one has seen God as God can "see God". Men see types [Moses]; angel [Manoah] & vision [Isa] but only God can see God. Jn 5:18-20; 6:46; 14:6-10
- **3**. How does Jesus see the Father? As *the only begotten God*.
- 4. who is in the bosom of the Father. 'monogenes', Logos w/ God, is God the Son
 - i. who is: verb re: God's being was [v1-2]. Pre-eternal, present: is.
 - **ii**. *in the bosom* = idiom: personal communion: table fellowship; marriage; parental love. Parallels v1-2 *w/ God.*
 - **a.** *Remember, we are like God but God is not like us.* Ware creatures & God is Creator. Our parent-child rlnshp is like God's but God's parent-child rlnshp w/i Godhead is not like ours. Ours is analogous: corresponding in some respects, but essentially different.
 - b. We must not start w/ ourselves & project us onto Gof: = idolatry, make God in our image. We are made in God's image: like, similarity.
 - **C.** Our experience of Father's love <u>Jn 17:24-26</u>: is a <u>creaturely</u> analogy of the Son's *in the bosom of the Father* love. *No one has seen God.*

2nd: The Only-Begotten Son in Relation to Us

- 1. *He has explained Him* [exegesis] = Jesus is the explanation of God as Savior. Lk 24:35; A 10:8; 15:12,14; 21;19 = to narrate events. Jesus, Himself, is the story & meaning of God's redemptive words & acts. What is God saving grace revealed in OCov & NCov? Jesus.
- 2. Yes, w/ Jesus, we learn that God is triune, but He explains the Father's words & acts for the purpose of our redemption. He is YHWH come to save us.
 - i. It is a theological misstep to begin w/ incarn Son of God & then go to Theology proper [Doct of God], to too to start w/ man. Nevertheless, Jesus, the Son, true image of God, does reveal God - [Hb 1:3] - <u>2C4:4</u>.
 - **ii**. The Son is God come to save & shine the light of the glory of gospel on us [Jn1:14] Jn 1:4-5 light, life, glory all in order to save us!
 - iii. We begin w/ God [OT YHWH] & receive God [NT Jesus]. Jn 1:1
- **3.** We could consider Jesus' 7 "I am" statements [bread of life; light of the world; door of the sheep; good shepherd; the res & the life; the way the truth & the life; the true vine. Jn 8:58 *I am* = YHWH [burning bush].
 - i. A statement of ontology. Jesus is the God of Israel: YHWH come to save.

Applic #1: As You Sit at the Table, Worship the Incarnate Son of God

1. On Xmas eve; the Son incarnate - LT: blood & body - crucified, resurrected, coming again. We do this in remembrance of Him.
