Intro:

"privilege": special right granted to citizens of a distinct community based on conditions. Such you have as members of the Visible Church: READ LC Q&A 63

<u>EP (Main point of text):</u> All God's people will come to Jesus and be accepted by Him.

<u>HP (Main application of text):</u> Come inside.

Move 1: In the Visible Church you receive God's special care.

LC: "being under God's special care and government":

- Special Care of God: His Personal interest and oversight:
 - And the LORD will create <u>upon every dwelling place of mount Zion, and upon her assemblies</u>, a cloud and smoke by day, and the shining of a flaming fire by night: for <u>upon all the glory</u> <u>shall be a defence</u>. And <u>there shall be a tabernacle</u> for a shadow in the daytime from the heat, and for <u>a place of refuge, and for a covert from storm and from rain</u>. (Isa 4:5-6)
 - For therefore we both labour and suffer reproach, because we trust in the living God, who is the Saviour of all men, specially of those that believe. (1Ti 4:10)
- Special government: delegated oversight through church officers:
 - Obey them that have the rule over you, and submit yourselves: <u>for they watch for your</u> <u>souls, as they that must give account</u>, that they may do it with joy, and not with grief: for that is unprofitable for you. (Heb 13:17)
 - And he gave some, apostles; and some, prophets; and some, evangelists; and some, pastors and teachers; <u>For the perfecting of the saints</u>, for the work of the ministry, for <u>the edifying of the body of Christ</u>: (Eph 4:11-12)

Move 2: In the Visible Church, you receive God's special protection.

LC: "being protected and preserved in all ages, notwithstanding the opposition of all enemies":

- Not unto us, O LORD, not unto us, but unto thy name give glory, for thy mercy, and for thy truth's sake. <u>Wherefore should the heathen say, Where is now their God? O Israel, trust thou</u> in the LORD: he is their help and their shield. (Psa 115:1-2, 9)
- For thus hath the LORD spoken unto me, Like as the lion and the young lion roaring on his prey, when a multitude of shepherds is called forth against him, he will not be afraid of their voice, nor abase himself for the noise of them: so <u>shall the LORD of hosts come down to fight</u> for mount Zion, and for the hill thereof. As birds flying, so will the LORD of hosts defend Jerusalem; defending also he will deliver it; and passing over he will preserve it. (Isa 31:4-5)
- READ Zechariah 12:2-4, 8-9:

Move 3: Don't neglect meaningful Family time in your Father's House.

LC: "enjoying the communion of saints, the ordinary means of salvation":

- For the promise is unto you, and to your children, and to all that are afar off, even as many as the Lord our God shall call. (Act 2:39)
- And they continued stedfastly in the apostles' doctrine and fellowship, and in breaking of bread, and in prayers. (Act 2:42): Basics of being the church together.

Move 4: Come in to hear Good News from your Brother.

LC: "and offers of grace by Christ to all the members of it in the ministry of the gospel, testifying, that whosoever believes in him shall be saved":

- He sheweth his word unto Jacob, his statutes and his judgments unto Israel. ²⁰ He hath not dealt so with any nation: and as for his judgments, they have not known them. Praise ye the LORD. (Psa 147:19-20)
- Who are Israelites; to whom pertaineth the adoption, and the glory, and the covenants, and the giving of the law, and the service of God, and the promises; (Rom 9:4)
- And he gave some, apostles; and some, prophets; and some, evangelists; and some, pastors and teachers; For the perfecting of the saints, for the work of the ministry, for the edifying of the body of Christ: (Eph 4:11-12)
- And he said unto them, Go ye into all the world, and preach the gospel to every creature. He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved; but he that believeth not shall be damned. (Mar 16:15-16).

Move 5: Jesus beckons you into His Father's home, and will not turn you away.

LC: "Christ ... excluding none that will come unto him". John 6:37:

- Context: telling those who don't believe in Him it is due to election.
- But those whom the Father gives Jesus come to Him. He beckons you to do so.
- IC is in view here, but where do you come to Jesus? Through His call in Visible Church.
- Where do you come close to Jesus and spend time with Him on this earth? Visible Church.
