I)The Final Phase is the fifth of the Five Phases of Salvation

A) The four other phases

1) The Eternal Phase

2)The Legal Phase

3)The Vital Phase.

4)The Practical Phase

B) The Final Phase occurs in eternity future and includes body, soul and spirit

C)The Final Phase saves from the presence of sin

D)The Final Phase sees the accomplishment of all details of the Eternal Phase

II) The purposes of God in the Eternal Phase shall come to pass in the end

<u>Isa14:24</u> The LORD of hosts hath sworn, saying, Surely as I have thought, so shall it come to pass; and as I have purposed, so shall it stand:

Isa 46:9 ...l am God, and there is none else; 1 am God, and there is none like me,

<u>Isa46:10</u>Declaring the end from the beginning, and from ancient times the things that are not yet done, saying, My counsel shall stand, and I will do all my pleasure:

Isa 46:11... yea, I have spoken it, I will also bring it to pass; I have purposed it, I will also do it.

III) The Final Phase of Salvation is certain for all who were in the Eternal Phase

<u>Ro8:30</u> Moreover whom he did predestinate, them he also called: and whomhe called, them he also justified: and whom he justified, them he also glorified.

(See entire passage: Ro 8:28-39)

<u>Joh 6:37</u>All that the Father giveth me shall come to me; and him that cometh to me 1 will in no wise cast out.

Joh 6:38 For I came down from heaven, not to do mine own will, but the will of him that sent me.

<u>Joh 6:39</u> And this is the Father's will which hath sent me, that **of all which he hath given me I should lose nothing**, but should **raise it up again at the last day.**

Joh 10:27 My sheep hear my voice, and 1 know them, and they follow me:

Joh10:28 And I give unto them eternal life; and they shall never perish, neither

shall any man pluck them out of my hand.

Joh 10:29 My Father, which gave them me, is greater than all; and no man is able to pluck them out of my Father's hand.

Heb2:13...Behold I and the children which God hath given me.

<u>Php1:6</u> Being confident of this very thing, that **he which hath begun a good work in you will perform** until the day of Jesus Christ:

<u>1Th5:23</u> And the very God of peace sanctify you **wholly**; and I pray God your **whole spirit and soul and body** be preserved blameless unto the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ.

1Th 5:24 Faithful v he that calleth you, who also will do it.

IV) The absolutely certain hope of eternal life for God's children

<u>1Pe 1:3</u> Blessed the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, which according to his abundant mercy hath **begotten us again unto** a lively hope by the resur-rection of Jesus Christ from the dead,

1Pe 1:4 To an inheritance incorruptible, and undefiled, and that fadeth not away, reserved in heaven for you,

Tit 1:2 In hope of eternal life, which God, that cannot lie, promised before the world began;

<u>Tit2:13</u>Looking for that blessed hope, and the glorious appearing of the great God and our Saviour Jesus Christ;

Tit 2:14 Who gave himself for us...

<u>Tit3:5</u> Not by works of righteousness which we have done, but according to his mercy he saved us, by the washing of regeneration, and renewing of the Holy Ghost;

<u>Tit 3:6</u> Which he shed on us abundantly through Jesus Christ our Saviour;

Tit 3:7 That being justified by his grace, we should be made heirs according to the hope of eternal life.

<u>Ro 8:18</u> For I reckon that the sufferings of this present time are not worthy compared with the glory which shall be revealed in us...

<u>Ro8:23</u> And not only they, but ourselves also, which have the firstfruits of the Spirit, even we ourselves groan within ourselves, waiting for the adoption, towit, the redemption of our body.

Ro8:24 For we are saved by hope: but hope that is seen is not hope: for what a man seeth, why doth he yet hope for?

Ro 8:25 But if we hope for that we see not, then do we with patience wait for it.

V)The spirit at death

<u>Lu23:42</u> And he said unto Jesus, Lord, remember me when thou comest into thy kingdom.

Lu23:43 And Jesus said unto him, Verily I say unto thee, To day shalt thou be with me in paradise.

2Co 5:8 We are confident, I say, and willing rather to be absent from the body, and to be present with the Lord.

<u>Lu20:37</u> Now that the dead are raised, even Moses shewed at the bush, when he calleth the Lord the God of Abraham, and the God of Isaac, and the God of Ja-cob.

<u>Lu 20:38</u> For he is not a God of the dead, but of the living...

Lu 16:22 And it came to pass, that the beggar died, and was carried by the angels into Abraham's bosom: the rich man also died, and was buried;

Lu16:23 And in hell he lift up his eyes, being in torments, and seeth Abraham afar off, and Lazarus in his bosom...

Lu 16:27 Then he said, I pray thee therefore, father, that thou wouldest send him to my father's house:

Lu 16:28 For I have five brethren; that he may testify unto them, lest they also come into this place of torment.

VI)The promise of Jesus' return

Ac 1:9 And when he had spoken these things, while they beheld, he was taken up; and a cloud received him out of their sight.

<u>Ac 1:10</u> And while they looked stedfastly toward heaven as he went up, behold, two men stood by them in white apparel;

<u>Ac 1:11</u> Which also said, Ye men of Galilee, why stand ye gazing up into heaven? this same Jesus, which is taken up from you into heaven, shall so come in like manner as ye have seen him go into heaven.

VII) As a thief—Jesus will come when the world least expects Him

- 2Pe3:3 Knowing this first, that there shall come in the last days scoffers, walking after their own lusts,
- <u>2Pe3:4</u> And saying, Where is the promise of his coming? for since the fathers fell asleep, all things continue as they were from the beginning of the creation.
- <u>2Pe3:5</u> For this they willingly are ignorant of, that by the word of God the heavens were of old, and the earth standing out of the water and in the water:
- <u>**2Pe** 3:6</u> Whereby the world that then was, being overflowed with water, perished:
- <u>2Pe3:7</u> But the heavens and the earth, which are now, by the same word are kept in store, reserved unto fire against the day ofjudgment and perdition of un-godly men.
- <u>2Pe3:8</u> But, beloved, be not ignorant of this one thing, that one day with the Lord as a thousand years, and a thousand years as one day.
- IPe 3:9 The Lord is not slack concerning his promise, as some men count slack-ness; but is longsuffering to us-ward, not willing that any should perish, but that all should come to repentance.
- <u>2Pe 3:10</u> But the day of the Lord will come **as a thief in the night;** in the which the heavens shall pass away with a great noise, and the elements shall melt with fervent heat, the earth also and the works that are therein shall be burned up.
- 21'e 3:12 Looking for and hasting unto the coming of the day of God, wherein the heavens being on fire shall be dissolved, and the elements shall melt with fer-vent heat?
- 2Pe 3:13 Nevertheless we, according to his promise, look for new heavens and a new earth, wherein dwelleth righteousness.
- <u>2Pe 3:14</u> Wherefore, beloved, seeing that ye look for such things, be diligent that ye may be found of him in peace, without spot, and blameless.
- <u>2Pe 3:15</u> And account that the longsuffering of our Lord salvation; even as our beloved brother Paul also according to the wisdom given unto him hath written unto you;
- 1Th 5:2 For yourselves know perfectly that the day of the Lord so cometh as a thief in the night.
- <u>1Th5:3</u> For when they shall say, Peace and safety; then sudden destruction cometh upon them, as travail upon a woman with child; and they shall not escape.
- 1Th 5:9 For God hath not appointed us to wrath, but to obtain salvation by our Lord Jesus Christ,
- <u>1Th5:10</u> Who died for t{s, that, whether we wake or sleep, we should live together with him.
- 1Th5:11 Wherefore comfort yourselves together, and edify one another, even as also ye do.

VIII)A general resurrection of the dead and a final separation

<u>Joh 5:28</u> Marvel not at this: for the hour is coming, in the which all that are in the graves shall hear his voice, <u>Joh 5:29</u> And shall come forth; they that have done good, unto the resurrection of

life; and they that have done evil, unto the resurrection of damnation.

Mt 25:31 When the Son of man shall come in his glory, and all the holy angels with him, then shall he sit upon the throne of his glory: Mai 25:32 And before him shall be gathered all nations: and he shall separate them one from another, as a shepherd divideth his sheep from the goats:

IX)Judgment of the wicked

- 2Th 1:6 Seeing it is a righteous thing with God to recompense tribulation to them that trouble you;
- 2Th 1:7 And to you who are troubled rest with us, when the Lord Jesus shall be re-vealed from heaven with his mighty angels,
- 2Th1:8 Inflaming fire taking vengeance on them that know not God, and that obey not the gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ:
- 2Th1:9 Who shall be punished with everlasting destruction from the presence of the Lord, and from the glory of his power;
- <u>Re 20:11</u> And I saw a great white throne, and him that sat on it, from whose face the earth and the heaven fled away; tmd there was found no place for them.
- Re 20:12 And I saw the dead, small and great, stand before God; and the books were opened: and another book was opened, which is the book of life: and the dead were judged out of those things which were written in the books, accord-ing to their works.
- <u>Re20:13</u> And the sea gave up the dead which were in it; and death and hell deliv-ered up the dead which were in them: and they were judged every man accord-ing to their works.
- <u>Re20:14</u> And death and hell were cast into the lake of fire. This is the second death.
- Re 20:15 And whosoever was not found written in the book of life was cast into the lake of fire.

X)Specifics about the resurrection of the bodies of God's children

- 1Th 4:13 But I would not have you to be ignorant, brethren, concerning them which are asleep, that ye sorrow not, even as others which have no hope.
- <u>1Th 4:14</u> For if we believe that Jesus died and rose again, even so **them also which sleep in Jesus will God bring with him.**<u>1Th 4:15</u> For this we say unto you by the word of the Lord, that we which are alive and remain unto the coming of the Lord shall not prevent them which are asleep.
- <u>1Th</u> 4:16 For the Lord himself shall descendfrom heaven with a shout, with the voice of the archangel, and with the trump of God: and the dead in Christ shall rise first:
- 1Th 4:17 Then we which are alive remain shall be caught up together with them in the clouds, to meet the Lord in the air: and so shall we ever be with the Lord.
- 1Th 4:18 Wherefore comfort one another with these words.
- <u>1Co 15:12</u> Now if Christ be preached that he rose from the dead, how say some among you that there is no resurrection of the dead?
- ICo 15:13 But if there be no resurrection of the dead, then is Christ not risen:
- 1Co 15:14 And if Christ be not risen, then our preaching vain, and your faith also vain.
- <u>1Co 15:15</u> Yea, and we are found false witnesses of God; because we have testified of God that he raised up Christ: whom he raised not up, if so be that the dead rise not.
- <u>1Co 15:16</u> For if the dead rise not, then is not Christ raised:
- 1Co15:17 And if Christ be not raised, your faith is vain; ye are yet in your sins.
- 1Co15:18 Then they also which are fallen asleep in Christ are perished.
- 1Co15:19If in this life only we have hope in Christ, we are of all men most mis-erable
- <u>1Co15:20</u>But now is Christ risen from the dead, and become the firstfruits of them that slept.
- 1Co 15:21 For since by man came death, by man came also the resurrection of the dead.

1Co 15:22 For as in Adam all die, even so in Christ: shall all be made alive.

<u>1Co15:42</u> So also is the resurrection of the dead. It is sown in corruption; it is raised in incorruption: <u>1Co 15:43</u> It is sown in dishonour; it is raised in glory: it is sown in weakness; it

is raised in power: 1Co 15:44 It is sown a natural body; it is raised a spiritual body...

1Co 15:49 And as we have bome the image of the earthy, we shall also bear the image of the heavenly.

<u>1Co 15:50</u> Now this I say, brethren, that flesh and blood cannot inherit the kingdom of God; neither doth corruption inherit incorruption.

1Co15:51 Behold, I shew you a mystery; We shall not all sleep, but we shall all be changed,

<u>1Co15:52</u> In a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trump: for the trumpet shall sound, and the dead shall be raised incorruptible, and we shall be changed.

1Co15:53 For this corruptible must put on incorruption, and this mortal shall put on immortality.

<u>1Co15:54</u> So when this corruptible shall have put on incorruption, and this mortal shall have put on immortality, then shall be brought to pass the saying that is written, **Death is swallowed up in victory.**

1Co 15:55 O death, where is thy sting? O grave, where thy victory?

1Co 15:56 The sting of death is sin; and the strength of sin is the law.

1Co15:57 But thanks be to God, which giveth us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ.

XI) Descriptions of what we will be

<u>1Jo3:1</u> Behold, what manner of love the Father hath bestowed upon us, that we should be called the sons of God: therefore the world knoweth us not, because it knew him not.

<u>1Jo 3:2</u> Beloved, now are we the sons of God, and it doth not yet appear what we shall be: but we know that, **when he shall appear, we shall be like him;** for we shall see him as he is.

Ps 17:15 As for me, I will behold thy face in righteousness: I shall be satisfied, when I awake, with thy likeness.

Ro 8:29 For whom he did foreknow, he also did predestinate to be conformed to the image of his Son, that he might be the firstborn among many brethren.

Php3:20 For our conversation is in heaven; from whence also we look for the Sav-iour, the Lord Jesus Christ:

Php 3:21 Who shall change our vile body, that it may be fashioned like unto his glorious body, according to the working whereby he is able even to subdue all things unto himself.

XII) The wonder of what waits for us

<u>Joh17:24</u> Father, l will that they also, whom thou hast given me, be with me where I am; that they may behold my glory, which thou hast given me: for thou lovedst me before the foundation of the world.

<u>Col 3:4</u> When Christ, who is our life, shall appear, then shall ye also appear with him in glory.

1Pe 5:4 And when the chief Shepherd shall appear, ye shall receive a crown of glory that fadeth not away.

<u>2Ti 4:6</u> For l am now ready to be offered, and the time of my departure is at hand. <u>2Ti 4:7</u> I have fought a goodfight, I have finished my course, I have kept the faith: **2Ti** 4:8 Henceforth there is **laid up for me a crown of righteousness**, which the Lord, the righteous judge, shall give me at that day: and **not to me only, but unto all them also that love his appearing.**

Joh 14:1 Let not your heart be troubled: ye believe in God. believe also in me. Joh 14:2In my Father's house are many

mansions: if it were not so, I would have told you. I go to prepare a place for you. <u>Joh 14:3</u> And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again, and receive you unto myself; that where I am, there ye may be also

<u>Re21:1</u> And I saw a new heaven and a new earth: for the first heaven and the first earth were passed away; and there was no more sea. <u>Re 21:2</u>, <u>1</u> John saw the holy city, new Jerusalem, coming down from God out of heaven, prepared as a bride adorned for her husband. <u>Re 21:3</u> And I heard a great voice out of heaven saying, Behold, the tabernacle of God is with men, and he will dwell with them, and they shall be his people, and God himself shall be with them, and be their God. <u>Re 21:4</u> And God shall wipe away all tears from their eyes; and there shall be no more death, neither sorrow, nor crying, neither shall there be any more pain: for the former things are passed away.
