GOD IS FOR YOUR BODY!

- **TEXT:** 1 Corinthians 6:13 Meats for the belly, and the belly for meats: but God shall destroy both it and them. Now the body is not for fornication, but for the Lord; and the Lord for the body.
- 14 And God hath both raised up the Lord, and will also raise up us by his own power.
- 19 What? know ye not that your body is the temple of the Holy Ghost which is in you, which ye have of God, and ye are not your own?
- 20 For ye are bought with a price: therefore glorify God in your body, and in your spirit, which are God's.

Jude 1:10 But these speak evil of those things which they know not: but **what they know naturally**, as **brute beasts**, in those things they corrupt themselves.
