Main Thought: At the end of 2020, what will be your next move?

## <u>Week in Review:</u> (Suggested Sharing Time 10 minutes)

• What is something you have been most grateful for during 2020? Where have you seen personal growth and group growth during the year?

## <u>Sermon Review:</u> (Suggested Time 20 minutes)

- What have been things that have caused you to lose sight of God's goodness this year? What might you do to change your perspective in the New Year?
- How, as a group, can you begin to embrace the mission and purpose of being Christ's witnesses to the world?
- Consider what has been the most challenging aspect of the last year and where do you need to embrace the promises of God more consistently?
- As a church this year we discussed the life of Abraham, considered our hearts, talked about our stories, walked in wisdom, sought compassion toward one another, thought about our neighbors, and addressed our posture toward prayer. Take time to review some of those thoughts and where God might be leading you 2021.

## Application: (Suggested Time 10 minutes)

- Reflect on the year. It may have been trying at times and 2021 may be no different for many of us. However, consider the goodness of God. His grace and His love for all people still remains. Find rest in these closing days of 2020! Look with anticipation to where He will show up in 2021!
