

YOUTH AND FOMO (DON'T MISS OUT!)

TEXT: Ecclesiastes 12:1 Remember now thy Creator in the days of thy youth, while the evil days come not, nor the years draw nigh, when thou shalt say, I have no pleasure in them;
2 While the sun, or the light, or the moon, or the stars, be not darkened, nor the clouds return after the rain:

3 In the day when the keepers of the house shall tremble, and the strong men shall bow themselves, and the grinders cease because they are few, and those that look out of the windows be darkened,
4 And the doors shall be shut in the streets, when the sound of the grinding is low, and he shall rise up at the voice of the bird, and all the daughters of musick shall be brought low;

5 Also when they shall be afraid of that which is high, and fears shall be in the way, and the almond tree shall flourish, and the grasshopper shall be a burden, and desire shall fail: because man goeth to his long home, and the mourners go about the streets:

6 Or ever the silver cord be loosed, or the golden bowl be broken, or the pitcher be broken at the fountain, or the wheel broken at the cistern.

7 Then shall the dust return to the earth as it was: and the spirit shall return unto God who gave it.

Ecclesiastes 12:13 Let us hear the conclusion of the whole matter: Fear God, and keep his commandments: for this is the whole duty of man.

14 For God shall bring every work into judgment, with every secret thing, whether it be good, or whether it be evil.



Numbers 15:40 That ye **may**
remember, and do all my

Psalm 100:2 Serve the Lord with gladness: come before his presence with singing.

13 And when thy herds and thy flocks multiply, and thy silver and thy gold is multiplied, and all that thou hast is multiplied;

14 Then thine heart be lifted up, and **thou forget** the LORD thy God, which brought thee forth out of the land of Egypt, from the house of bondage;

17 And thou say in thine heart, **My power and the might of mine hand hath gotten me this wealth.**

18 But **thou shalt remember the LORD** thy God: for it is he that giveth thee power to get wealth...

19 And it shall be, if thou do at all **forget the LORD** thy God, and walk after other gods, and serve them, and worship them, I testify against you this day that ye shall surely perish.

Proverbs 13:15 Good understanding
giveth **favour**: but the way of
transgressors is **hard**.

Psalms 119:45 And I will walk **at liberty**:
for I seek **thy precepts**.
