#### INTRODUCTION

- 1. <u>Isa 9:6-7</u> 4 couplets = 4 names. 1 person, 2 natures: human & divine. Rule over God's government sitting on David's throne Mat 1:21-23.
- 2. Messiah's kingdom is a kingdom of salvation.

### 1st: The Name Wonderful Counselor

- 1. A Wonder of a Counselor. Wonder = deity. Unfathomable, transcendent. OT used re: God miraculous deliverances [Exo 15:11; Ps 77:14; Isa 25:1].
  - i. Angel of Lord visits Samon's parents <u>Jdg 13:15-20</u>
  - ii. Isa 9:6 the promised Davidic King is divine: He is wonderful.
- 2. *Counselor* = Jesus' humanity: advisor embodies divine wisdom & purpose
  - i. <u>Isa 28:29</u> This son will be the incarnation of divine wisdom.
  - ii. Counsel plan or purpose. Decree; sovereign rule. <u>Isa</u> 40:13-14. None can counsel the Wonderful Counselor. Isa 46:10b
- 3. What is the counsel & purpose of the Wonderful Counselor? <u>Isa 45:20-25</u>
  - Idolatrous nations taunted to consult [our term: counsel] & devise a plan of salvation (idols cannot save). But YHWH has a plan as the only true God & Savior whose salvation extends to the ends of the earth.
  - ii. This kingdom of salvation is ruled by Jesus: the *Wonderful Counselor*

## 2nd: The Name Mighty God

- Couplet identifies divine/human Messiah: El Gibbor. El =
  "God" coupled w/ attributes. God of the Mtn Ex 6:3; God
  Most High Gn 14:18; God of Eternity Gn 21:33; Gof the
  Seeing One Gn 16:13; God of Compassion Dt 4:31; God of
  Forgiveness Ps 99:8; God of Grace Neh 9:31; God of Jealousy Ex 20:5. Isa 9:6 prophesies Messiah's deity.
- 2. Gibbor: Mighty as noun = warrior [156x in OT]; as adjective = "Almighty". Mighty God in war & judgment: [Dt 10:17; Ps 24:8; Jer 32:18; Neh 9:32a].
  - i. Song of Moses defeat Pharaoh's army. *Lord is a warrior* [Exo 15:3].
  - ii. <u>Isa 10:21</u> mighty God [Isa 9:6] depicts God saving His people.
  - iii. Zeph 3:14-17 return of exiles joy of victory & peace after conflict
- 3. Isa 9:6 does what "messianic Pss" do: prophesy the divine Son of David.
  - i. Jesus' use of Ps 110:1 [Lk 20:41] How can Davi'd's Lord be David's son? Ans = incarnation of the Son of God: 1 person in 2 natures
  - ii. cf. Ps 45:1 a wedding song [bride addressed in v10ff]
    - a. v3 King is a warrior O Mighty One.
    - b. v6-7 King is God & the anointed Messiah
    - C. <u>Heb 1:8-9</u> cites Ps 45:6-7 fulfilled by enthroned Jesus: Divine King.

## Applic #1: We Must Know Jesus in Terms of His God-Given Names

- 1. Only God can reveal His names.
- 2. We traffic in the IIIrd commandment Exo 20:7.

### Applic #2: We Must Know the Historical Jesus

- 1. History concerns space & time. Isa 9:6 birth of an historical person
- 2. Where? <u>Isa 9:1-9</u>. When? <u>Mat 4:12-17</u>
- 3. Do not deny the historical Jesus or His supernatural mission. The divine Son of God incarnate to accomplish our salvation supernaturally.

# Applic #3: The Promised Son Has Come to Accomplish God's Purpose.

- 1. <u>Heb 10:5-10</u> The incarnate divine Son accomplished our human salvation.
- 2. When He comes into the world [v5], He quotes Ps 40. The Wonderful Counselor & Mighty God comes into the world for a purpose 2C5:21.

# Applic #4: Biblical, Historical Jesus Calls Us to be Biblical, Historical Disciples

- **1.** The salvation that Jesus has accomplished is also historically applied historically by the Holy Spirit to real sinners who Jesus really saves.
- 2. If the Son of God assumed humanity for our salvation, if we're saved, let's give Him our entire humanity.
