I solemnly charge you, in the sight of God and of Christ Jesus, who is about to judge living and dead, and by His appearing and His kingdom: ² herald the word! Be at it seasonably, unseasonably! Reprove! Rebuke! Exhort! — with all longsuffering and instruction.

³ For the season shall be when they will not put up with healthy teaching, but *instead*, in accord with their own desires, will heap up for themselves teachers, because they have itching ears. ⁴ And on the one hand, they will turn away their ears from the truth and, on the other, will turn aside to stories.

⁵ But as for you, you stay sober in all things. Suffer ill. Do the work of an evangelist. Fully accomplish your service.

⁶ For as for me, already I am being made a drink-offering, and the season for my departure is at hand.² ⁷ The good fight, I have fought; the course, I have finished; the faith, I have kept. ⁸ Henceforth is laid up for me the crown of righteousness, which the Lord will repay to me in that Day, the righteous Judge; and not only to me, but also to all who have loved His appearing!
