## I. The Glory We Share

- A. Christ's glory has been revealed! In his...
  - 1. Birth John 1:14; Luke 2:32
  - 2. Crucifixion 1 Corinthians 2:8
  - 3. Transfiguration! Luke 9
  - 4. Resurrection Luke 24:26; 1 Peter 1:21
  - 5. Ascension 1 Tim 3:16
  - 6. Glory we can see 2 Corinthians 4:6
- B. Our glory with Christ
  - 2 Corinthians 3:18; 1 Peter 4:14; 2 Thessalonians 2:14: John 17:22
- C. Glory that does not fade
  - 1. Contrasting *glory* of the law with *glory* of Christ.
    - a. The law
      - Came with glory (7)
      - Brought condemnation (9)
      - Is being brought to an end (11)
    - b. The ministry of the Spirit
      - Gives life! (6)
      - With greater glory (8)
    - c. The *new* overshadows the *old* (10)
      - The "old" is not destroyed It is *overcome* with the greater glory

EXAMPLE: The brightness of a full moon vs. the risen sun

- 2. The veil of Moses (12ff)
  - Veiled before the people
  - Uncovered before the Lord
- D. Taking hold of glory
  - 1. Turn to the Lord! (16)
    - a. Removing the veil
      - Our futile attempts at glory
      - Glory shared with us in Christ Jesus
    - b. For freedom (17)

## I. The Glory We Share (cont.)

- D. Taking hold of glory (cont.)
  - 2. Transformed by Christ (18)
    - a. With unveiled faces
    - b. Transformed
      - From one degree of glory to another
    - c. Beholding His glory
      - 1) Transformed by beholding His glory!
      - 2) Not by reflecting (or attempting to) that glory Not By Works!

  - 4. Ascension
    - -1 Peter 1:21

  - 1. Humility
    - 1 Peter 5:6; James 4:10
  - 2. Suffering
    - Romans 8:18; 2 Corinthians 4:17; 1 Peter 5:10
