- I. ACCOUNT: "a certain nobleman..." (vv.11-14)
 - **A. Repetition:** "went on to tell a parable" (v.11)
 - **B. Responsibility:** "nobleman/slaves/business" (vv.12-13)
 - 1. Travel: "to receive a kingdom...and return" (v.12)
 - 2. Trust: "called...slaves...gave them ten minas" (v.13a)
 - 3. Transactions: "Do business...until I come back" (v.13b)
 - **C. Rejection:** "his citizens hated him" (v.14)
- II. ACCOUNTING: "when he returned..." (vv.15-23)
 - **A. Requirement:** "he ordered...slaves...be called" (v.15)
 - **B. Reports:** "first...second...another" (vv.16-21)
 - C. Rebuke: "I will judge you" (vv.22-23)
- III. <u>ALLOCATION</u>: "take the mina...give it" (vv.24-27)
 - **A. Loss of Reward:** "take the mina away" (vv.24-26)
 - 1. Recompense: "give it to the one who has the ten" (v.24)
 - 2. Removal: "what he does have...taken away" (vv.25-26)
 - **B.** Loss of Life: "slay them in my presence" (v.27)
 - 1. Snatched: "bring them here"
 - 2. Slaughtered: "slay them in my presence"
