6. THE SIFUL WOMAN HAS SHOWN LIVING THROUGH HER ACTIONS OF POSSESSING SAVING FAITH.

Verses 48-50 And He said to her, "**Your sins have been forgiven**." 49 And those who were reclining {at the table} with Him began to say to themselves, "Who is this {man} who even forgives sins?" 50 And He said to the woman, "**Your faith has saved you; go in peace**

Luke 17:11-19 And it came about while He was on the way to Jerusalem, that He was passing between Samaria and Galilee. 12 And as He entered a certain village, ten leprous men who stood at a distance met Him; 13 and they raised their voices, saying, "Jesus, Master, have mercy on us!" 14 And when He saw them, He said to them, "Go and show yourselves to the priests." And it came about that as they were going, they were cleansed.

15 Now one of them, when he saw that he had been healed, turned back, glorifying God with a loud voice, 16 and he fell on his face at His feet, giving thanks to Him. James 4:8-10 Draw near to God and He will draw near to you. Cleanse your hands, you sinners; and purify your hearts, you double-minded. 9 Be miserable and mourn and weep; let your laughter be turned into mourning, and your joy to gloom. 10 Humble yourselves in the presence of the Lord, and He will exalt you.

Mark 14:3-9 And while He was in Bethany at the home of Simon the leper, and reclining {at the table,} there came a woman with an alabaster vial of very costly perfume of pure nard; {and} she broke the vial and poured it over His head. 4 But some were indignantly {remarking} to one another, "Why has this perfume been wasted? 5 "For this perfume might have been sold for over three hundred denarii, and {the money} given to the poor." And they were scolding her. 6 But Jesus said, "Let her alone; why do you bother her? 3. THE PHARISEE ______ TO HIMSELF ABOUT THE SINFUL WOMAN'S ACTIONS.

4. JESUS TELLS SIMON THE PHARISEE A STORY ABOUT AND LOVE.

Which of them therefore will love him more?" 43 Simon answered and said, "**I suppose** the one whom he forgave more." And He said to him, "You have judged correctly."

James 1:23-25 For if anyone is a hearer of the word and not a doer, he is like a man who looks at his natural face in a mirror; ²⁴ for once he has looked at himself and gone away, he has immediately forgotten what kind of person he was. ²⁵ But one who has looked intently at the perfect law, the law of freedom, and has continued in it, not having become a forgetful hearer but an active doer, this person will be blessed in what he does.

Luke 19:2-10 And behold, there was a man called by the name of Zaccheus; and he was a chief tax-gatherer, and he was rich. 3 And he was trying to see who Jesus was, and he was unable because of the crowd, for he was small in stature. 4 And he ran on ahead and climbed up into a sycamore tree in order to see Him, for He was about to pass through that way. 5 And when Jesus came to the place, He looked up and said to him, "Zaccheus, hurry and come down, for today I must stay at your house." 6 And he hurried and came down, and received Him gladly. 7 And when they saw it, they all {began} to grumble, saying, "He has gone to be the guest of a man who is a sinner." 8 And Zaccheus stopped and said to the Lord, "Behold, Lord, half of my possessions I will give to the poor, and if I have defrauded anyone of anything, I will give back four times as much." 9 And Jesus said to him, "Today salvation has come to this house, because he, too,
