

## PROPHETIC OVERVIEW

**Text:** Psalm 2

- I. THE KINGS OF THE EARTH IN REBELLION (vv. 1-3)
  - a. The rebellion is futile (v. 1)
  - b. The rebellion is between mortal kings on earth and God enthroned in the heavens (v. 2)
  - c. The rebels resolve not to submit to God's authority (vv. 2-3)
    - i. An ancient and continuing war
    - ii. But God promised a victorious seed
- II. GOD RESOLVES TO APPOINT A KING (vv. 4-6)
  - a. God finds their plan ridiculous (v. 4)
  - b. God will end their plan by installing His anointed (vv. 5-6)
  - c. The king to be installed on Mt. Zion (v. 6)
- III. GOD APPOINTS THE KING (vv. 7-9)
  - a. The first advent of the Son of God (v. 7)
    - i. The Son rules by divine decree
    - ii. The resurrection is the Son's coronation
  - b. Between the advents
    - i. Jesus builds His church
    - ii. Jesus raptures His church
  - c. The second advent of the Son of God (vv. 8-9)
    - i. Global dominion is given to the Son
      - 1. The Tribulation / Daniel's 70<sup>th</sup> Week
      - 2. The Marriage Supper of the Lamb
    - ii. The Son quashes the rebellion with divine authority
      - 1. The Battle of Armageddon
      - 2. The Son's earthly kingdom established
  - d. The New Heavens and the New Earth
    - i. The final defeat of the evil one
    - ii. The Great White Throne Judgment
    - iii. The curse is gone and everything is new
    - iv. God and His people dwelling together forever
- IV. THE WORLD EXHORTED TO ACCEPT THE KING (vv. 10-12)
  - a. The kings of the earth exhorted with wisdom (v. 10)
  - b. The exhortation to serve and rejoice (v. 11)
  - c. The exhortation to honor and trust (v. 12)
