      - a. *Strong habitation*-place to find strength when one is \_\_\_\_\_ strength
      - b. *I may continually resort*-constantly run \_\_\_\_\_
      - c. *Thou hast given commandment to save me*-the sovereign God has spoken and it cannot be \_\_\_\_\_
      - d. *Thou are my rock and fortress*-a place of stability and \_\_\_\_\_
  - C. The One who has been with him from his \_\_\_\_\_ Vs 6-8
    1. God has always been there for him, even though many have not \_\_\_\_\_ him Vs 6-7
    2. This truth brings \_\_\_\_\_ to the Psalmist's heart and praise to his lips for God Vs 8
- II. \_\_\_\_\_ for God's protection and deliverance Vs 9-13
- A. In his \_\_\_\_\_ age Vs 9
    1. After he has become old Vs 9a
    2. After he has lost much of his \_\_\_\_\_ ability Vs 9b
  - B. His enemies are just as \_\_\_\_\_ as they were when he was young Vs 10-11
    1. They still \_\_\_\_\_ against him and plot his destruction Vs 10
    2. They see him as \_\_\_\_\_ in his old age Vs 11
      - a. His enemies feel God has \_\_\_\_\_ him in his old age Vs 11a
      - b. His enemies feel he is easy \_\_\_\_\_ in his old age Vs 11b
  - C. He asks God for protection and deliverance Vs 12-13
    1. He asks for \_\_\_\_\_ deliverance Vs 12
    2. He asks that his enemies be \_\_\_\_\_ Vs 13
      - a. *Confounded*-\_\_\_\_\_, humiliated, embarrassed
      - b. *Consumed*-cease to \_\_\_\_\_, completely removed forever from his life
      - c. *Covered with reproach and dishonor*-engulfed with \_\_\_\_\_, taunting and humiliation
- III. \_\_\_\_\_ of God's majesty and honor in his life Vs 14-24
- A. His \_\_\_\_\_ is in God Vs 14a
    1. *Hope*-\_\_\_\_\_ confidence
    2. *Continually-unending* no matter what the \_\_\_\_\_ may be or look like
  - B. His \_\_\_\_\_ will be to God Vs 14b-17
    1. His continual hope will \_\_\_\_\_ him to worship God
    2. His deliverances have come from God-the times God has delivered David are so numerous he cannot \_\_\_\_\_ them all
    3. His \_\_\_\_\_ to live comes from God Vs 16
    4. His \_\_\_\_\_ has come from God Vs 17
  - C. In his \_\_\_\_\_ age, David is still trusting in God Vs 18-21
    1. He desires to share his experiences with the \_\_\_\_\_ generation Vs 18

2. He still acknowledges that God is worthy of sharing because of His \_\_\_\_\_ character Vs 19
  - a. He does not \_\_\_\_\_ God for the difficult times in his life, even though he knows God allowed them Vs 20a
  - b. He believes God will see him through those hard times and give him \_\_\_\_\_ over them Vs 20b-21

    - (2) *Bring me up again from the depths of the earth-lift me up from the "\_\_\_\_\_ " I find myself in emotionally*
