<u>Introduction</u>

What we believe about Jesus matters.

1John 2:22-23; 4:1-3, 14-15; 5:1, 5, 12, 20

"The themes developed in vv. 12-20 are enlarged upon throughout the rest of this chapter.

"They include:

Where Jesus comes from (vv. 23, 26, 29); Where He is going (vv. 21-22, 28); Who the Father is (vv. 26-27, 38, 54-55); Who Jesus is (vv. 23-26, 38, 54-55)

"The opposite of each of these themes is applied to the Jews.

Jesus is from above, they are from below (v. 23)
They are from this world, Jesus is not from this world (v. 23)
Where Jesus goes, they cannot come (v. 21)
God is His Father, theirs is the devil (vv. 26-27, 41-44, 54-55)"

Jesus Confronts the Jews with their inability to go where He is going and the consequences of their inability

21Then He said again to them,

"I go away, and you will seek Me, and will die in your sin;

where I am going, you cannot come."

John 7:33-34

Consequences

"you will die in your sin"

The Jews Inability to understand what Jesus is saying

22 So the Jews were saying,

"Surely He will not kill Himself, will He, since He says, 'Where I am going,

you cannot come'?"

John 7:35-36

Jesus' explains what he has said

²³And He was saying to them,

"You are from below, I am from above;

you are of this world, I am not of this world.

Jesus again warns the Jews of their dire condition

24"Therefore I said to you that you will die in your sins;

for unless you believe that I am He, you will die in your sins."

"<u>I am He</u>" – also in John 8:28, 58 (8:12 "I am the light of the world... - Isa. 42:6)

See Isaiah 41:4; 43:10, 13, 25; 46:4 48:12; cf. also Deut. 32:39; Ex. 3:14

John 5:18 "For this reason therefore the Jews were seeking all the more to kill Him because...He was calling God His own Father, making Himself equal with God."

Exception clause – "unless"

"<u>unless</u> you believe that I am He, you will die in your sins"

The Jews don't understand what Jesus has been saying to them

25 So they were saying to Him, "Who are You?"

Jesus' Response

Jesus said to them,

"What have I been saying to you from the beginning?

26"I have many things to speak and to judge concerning you,

but He who sent Me is true;

and the things which I heard from Him, these I speak to the world."

John 8:15-16

John's Explanation

27They did not realize that He had been speaking to them about the Father.

Jesus' explanation

28 So Jesus said,

"When you lift up the Son of Man,

John 3:12-15

then you will know that

I am He, and

I do nothing on My own initiative,

but I speak these things as the Father taught Me.

29"And He who sent Me is with Me;

He has not left Me alone,

for I always do the things that are pleasing to Him."

John 4:34

John 5:19ff.

Result

30 As He spoke these things, many came to believe in Him.
