Origin

- 1) Made by God
- 2) Satan is a fallen angel
- 3) Satan was lifted with pride

Work

- 1) Satan introduced sin to the human family
- 2) Satan possesses and controls the world that is opposed to Christ

Satan's Work...

- 3) Satan accuses God's people
 - Devil means accuser or slanderer
 - Job 1:6, 9; 2:3-5
 - Unbelievers rejoice when followers of Christ sin
 - -Rev. 12:9-10

"[Satan] sometimes slanders God to men; as to Eve... sometimes men to God; as Job... and continually, man to man."

- Satan loves for us to accuse one another so he may divide us

- 4) Satan tests, hinders, resists and buffets the people of God
 - Luke 22:31-32
 - I Thess. 2:18
 - II Cor. 12:7
 - "buffet" means to rap or beat with the fist

Satan's Work...

- 5) Satan seeks to oppose and hinder the work of God
 - Matthew 13:39
 - Fights against God's kingdom
 - Plants his own seeds
 - II Cor. 11:13-15; II Thess. 2:8-10
 - Satan is good at deceit
 - Religious camouflage
 - Mark 4:15
 - Snatches the seed

Satan likes to confuse the lines between what is of Christ and what is not...

- 6) Satan tempts, ensnares and lead men into evil
 - Acts 5:3
 - I Chron. 21:1; John 13:2; James 1:13
 - He tempts by telling people lies about sin

"The devil has three ways by which he makes men seek after him. First, commonly he covers holiness with other names. Secondly, he persuades men that sins are but little. Thirdly, that they may be repented of hereafter."

- 7) Satan controls and blinds the lost Acts 26:18
 - II Cor. 4:4 Satan blinds minds
 - II Tim. 2:24-26 Holds people captive

-God can command the light to shine

-Satan indeed has been given power over men but he is not powerful over God

- 8) Satan has the ability to cause sickness and death
 - Luke 13:16
 - Acts 10:38 and Heb. 2:14

The Destiny of Satan

- Satan is not now in hell
- He will be bound during the Millennium Rev. 20:1-7
- His final abode will be the Lake of Fire Rev. 20:7-10
- Sometimes we give the Devil too much credit and sometimes we don't give him enough
- Sometimes we give him too much power and sometimes we act like he has no power
- Sometimes we give him too much preeminence in Hell
