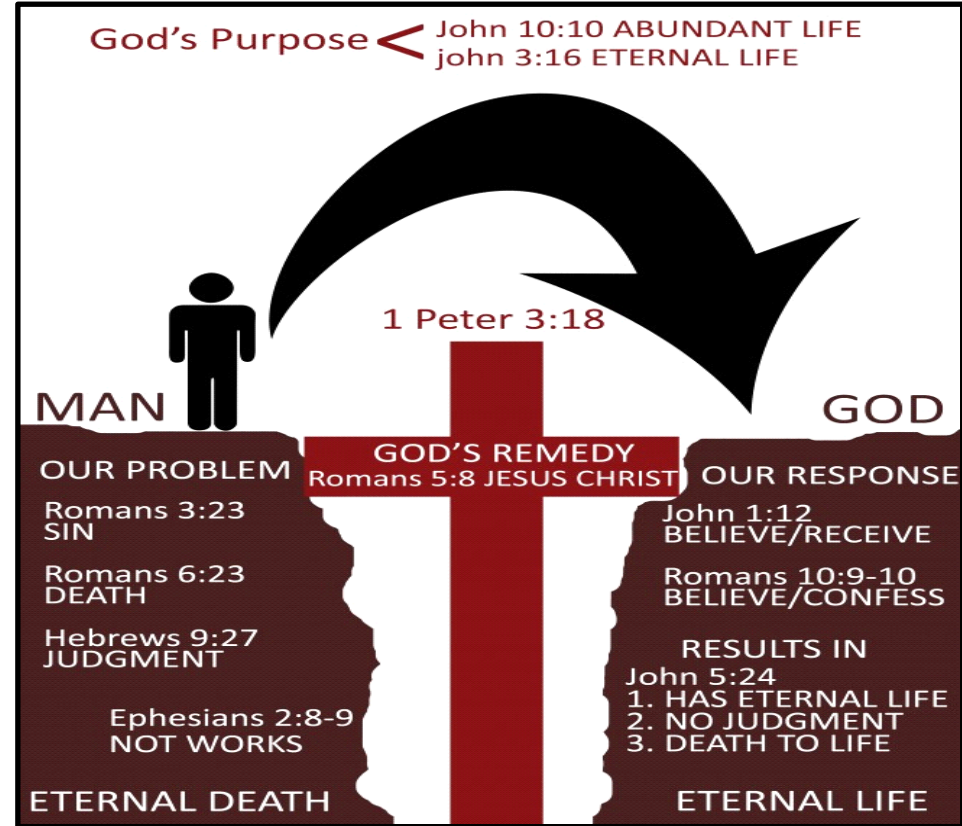

Loyalties (4)
1 Samuel 20:

The covenant of friendship between Jonathan and David.

There was mutual honesty in their relationship - v. 1–2

- David was willing to be examined.
- Jonathan was being lied to by Saul but he would not lie to David.
- True friends will never lie you and always tell you the truth - **Proverbs 26:28**

There was commitment in their relationship - v. 3–4

- David went to Jonathan because at this point, he is the only friend he can trust.
- Jonathan promised to do whatever he could for David's sake.
- True friends will always be there and help each other.

There was mutual cooperation in their relationship - v. 5–7

- Both men agreed on a plan to settle the matter.
- Both men had much to lose, but both men trusted the Lord to bring a solution.
- True friends will always seek to resolve conflict and find solutions to problems.

There was mutual respect in their relationship - v. 8–13

- David put his life into Jonathan's hands.
- Jonathan never believed David sinned and would not allow him to be falsely accused.
- True friends always trust each other.

There was mutual love in their relationship - v. 14–17

- David promised to not consider the son of Saul and his house an enemy.
- Jonathan believed the Lord would make David king and so he offered him his devoted and loyal love.
- True friends always love each other.

Have you put your faith in the greater Son of David - **John 3:16 For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life.**

Do you love the Lord Jesus Christ? **1 Corinthians 16:22 If anyone does not love the Lord Jesus Christ, let him be accursed. O Lord, come!**

Brother and sister, we have nothing to offer the King but our heart - **James 2:5 Listen, my beloved brethren: Has God not chosen the poor of this world to be rich in faith and heirs of the kingdom which He promised to those who love Him?**
