

The King Enters Jerusalem

Luke 19:28-40

- 1) The King arrives in Jerusalem (19:28-34)
 - a) As the Son of Man, He comes to be tortured & killed (18:31-33)
 - b) As the humble King, he rides in on a humble colt (19:36)
 - c) At His return, He comes on a white war horse (Rev. 19:11)
- 2) Jesus is to be praised as He who comes in the name of the Lord (19:35-40)
- 3) Jesus fulfills OT prophecies about the coming Messiah, or Christ
 - a) Born of Abraham, Judah, a virgin, in Bethlehem, Nazareth, etc.
 - b) Rode into town on a colt (Zech. 9:9; cf. Gen 49:8-12)
 - c) Arrived on a specific prophesied day (Dan. 9:24-26)
 - i) Monday Nisan 10, or March 30, AD 33 (cf. Exod. 12:3)
 - ii) 483 years (69 sevens) after a decree on March 5, 444 BC to rebuild Jerusalem (cp. Dan. 9:24-26 with Neh. 2:1-8)
 - iii) “cut off” (Dan. 9:26) four days later (cf. Exod. 12:6) on Friday April 3, AD 33
- 4) Food for Thought
 - a) Realize your sinful depravity, your inability to gain God’s favor
 - b) Recognize that Jesus is the Christ, the perfect Lamb who atones for all our sins
