We continue in our series on applied doctrine, and in particular, the Covenant of Grace Applied. God's promises to the church in Jeremiah 32:38-41 is to correct the problem of the divided heart among a people who feared the Lord but served their idols, including their children and their children's children (See 2 Kings 17:41).

In preparation for Sunday, I encourage you to read Jeremiah 31-32 keenly looking for the Covenant of Grace, what God promises within it, the intended effects God's designs for his people, and our mutual responsibility as a consequence of God giving Grace to us.

Read Jeremiah 32:38-41 several times for familiarity, and use the outline to pray through it, praying for your benefit personally, for me as I seek to preach and apply such a glorious promise as the Covenant of Grace, and for our church in receiving God's intended blessings for our mutual good.
