## The Priority of Faith

Hebrews 10:39-11:40

- I. What we need in order to love God and others
  - A. We *must* love God and others no one will see God without holiness; our works will reveal us at judgment;
  - B. We need a heart that desires to love and obey God.
  - C. We need to know that we have been reconciled to God.
  - D. We need a confident expectation of future joy.
  - E. We must be sure that we have the strength necessary to obey God and love him
- II. So what do you do if you find yourself stuck in sin?
  - A. Running back over and over again to the same false comforts?
  - B. Falling into the same patterns of thought and speech?
  - C. Finding yourself cold (or lukewarm) toward God?
  - D. Whether you are a non-Christian, a new Christian, or a mature Christian, you will face this question.
- III. The obedience of faith
  - A. There are many factors in overcoming sin, but they all begin with faith!
  - B. If you are staring down the barrel of sins you don't want to give up, put your faith in Jesus Christ. (John 6:28-29; Romans 1:5; 2 Timothy 3:15; Romans 10:4; Galatians 4:1; Romans 2:28; Isaiah 64:6)
  - C. Objection: faith is too easy! (2 Kings 5:12-13)
  - D. Objection: faith is too hard! (Psalm 110:3)
  - E. Objection: faith gives false assurance!
- IV. The constant renewal of faith
  - A. "Without faith it is impossible to please God, for whoever would draw near to God must believe that he exists and that he rewards those who seek him." (Hebrews 11:6)
  - B. Abide in Him. (John 15:4-5)
  - C. Come to Him. (Revelation 22:16-17)
  - D. Look to Him. (Numbers 21:9; John 3:14-15; Hebrews 12:1-2)
  - E. Faced with your sin and helplessness, trust in him and he will help you.
