I. Woe to the Self-Indulgent Rich

- B. Pride Is Hollow but Blinding (6:13; John 3:27; 1 Cor 4:7)
- C. Pride Provokes the Lord's Anger (6:8-11, 14; Luke 18:14)

- 5. How does the gospel deliver us from the idolatry of riches? How does it save us from our pride?
