Recap

- In the last 2 messages we read of:
 - Nineveh <u>repenting</u> ~ of God extending <u>mercy</u>
 - o Jonah's intense anger at their not being judged
- We've now read all of Jonah .. Think on what I just read .. Think about God ..
 - o "After reading Jonah chapter 4, what is your impression of God?"

The Book of Jonah

- <u>III</u>: <u>James Taylor</u> (World Series) & <u>Carly Simon</u> ~ "You're So Vain"
 - Wikipedia page on the mystery c/the identity of the person
 - But, the song ironically <u>is</u> all about this man
- "What is the book of Jonah about?"
 - o Is it about Jonah spending 3 days in a fish? No ..
 - o Is it about the salvation of 120k+ Ninevites? No..
 - o It is about the hard unforgiving heart of one man named Jonah

v4 & v9 ~ "Is it Right for You to be Angry?"

- v5 ~ Jonah went off by himself to brood & stew in his anger
 - He made himself a shelter ~ but (v6) God also shaded it
 - Jonah appreciated this kindness ~ this mercy ~ towards him
- $v7 \sim$ But what God gave him one day \sim He took away the next
 - He also ordained a (v8) hot sun and a strong east wind
 - o Jonah grew faint from the heat and wished again to die
- v9 ~ God asks a <u>second time</u> about <u>Jonah's anger</u> (now about the <u>plant</u>)
 - $\circ\hspace{0.1in}$ Jonah says it right for him to even wish for death ..
 - God points out that Jonah pitied the plant ~ not only himself
 - Perhaps the plant was beautiful (in addition to being useful)

I asked you earlier for your <u>impression of God</u> after reading Jonah 4 What is that impression? Wonder ..

At His <u>patience</u> with Jonah who is being so <u>stubborn</u> and <u>hard-hearted</u>?

But God had set His love upon Jonah ~ He was not abandoning him ..

God sets His love upon us every Lord's Day at this, His Table ..

Jonah is not about Jonah's hard-heart & unforgiveness ~ but God's abundant mercy
