These questions are provided for your further study and application of today's sermon. Thoughtfully writing out the answers to these questions will help to drive home the point of today's study. It is also helpful when you are able to discuss your answers with others.

- 1. Read Exodus 34:14; Acts 14:11-15; Revelation 19:9-10; Matthew 14:32-33 and Luke 24:50-53. Why is it helpful to consider the proper and acceptable worship of Jesus, which is egregious when directed to men or angels?
- 2. Read **Hebrews 1:1-4**. We talk a lot around Compass about having "a high view of God," why is this particularly important when considering our thoughts and attitudes regarding Jesus, the second person of the Godhead?
- 3. Read **Daniel 7:9-14** and **Revelation 1:12-18**. Consider the descriptions in these texts of the "Ancient of Days" and the "Son of Man." How can these passages aid your worship and adoration of the incarnate Christ?
- 4. Read **John 1:14** and **Luke 2:52**. How is your mind stretched and your appreciation heightened when considering the two natures of the incarnate Christ—his full divinity and full humanity?
- 5. Read Luke 19:10 and Philippians 2:3-11. How and why does the purpose of the incarnation humble you and drive you to live for Christ this week?
