**Key Phrase—vv. 1b-2a: *“To the pilgrims of the Dispersion in Pontus, Galatia, Cappadocia, Asia, and Bithynia, elect according to the foreknowledge of God the Father, in sanctification of the Spirit, for obedience and sprinkling of the blood of Jesus Christ.”***

Aim: To be so closely tied to Jesus that we endure all things well
