- A. Consecrate yourselves to God by the mercies of God (Rom. 2:4, 9:22, 5:5, 3:24)**

- B. Present your bodies to God (Gen. 2:7, Ps. 101:3, 1 Cor. 6:20, 2 Cor. 10:5)**

- C. Living sacrifices of the New Covenant are more valuable than the dead sacrifices of the Old Covenant (Romans 6:11, 19; Heb. 13:15-16)**
