Joy FOR the World...

Because King Jesus Wins, 1-3

- An exuberant praise song
- · Sing a new song to celebrate what God has done
- · "Old" songs praise for creation
 - o All nature sings that song, cf. Psalm 19, Psalm 8; Job 38.7
- "New" song: God's works of salvation
 - o We sing because God has done marvelous things
 - o His acts of salvation, cf. Exodus 15; Revelation 5.9ff
- God's kingdom coming in all its fullness
 - o One day everyone will sing it, willingly or not
 - o Revelation 11.15 ultimately
- · Jesus' great works when on earth

Because King Jesus Reigns Now, 4-6

- · Obviously, we need a King
- · People are blinded to King Jesus
- · We must proclaim King Jesus' reign

Because He is the Judge, 7-9

- Pain, suffering, injustice
- · A judge who will make all things right
- · The greatest orchestra ever assembled
 - o Nature's music
 - o Created music
 - o All together, cf. Romans 8.19-21
- Everything will be made right!
- A singing faith!
 - o Singing in heaven, Revelation 15
- A mashup Maxine Cummins-style of the Song of Moses and the Song of the Lamb
