## Put Your Hope in the LORD Psalm 130

## Main Point:

When you are distressed by your sin, put your hope in the LORD.

1. As a Christian, you will sometimes be distressed by your sin.

- 2. In these times, cry out to the LORD in prayer and seek His mercy.
- 3. In these times, remember the LORD's forgiveness and respond accordingly.
- 4. In these times, set your eyes on the LORD's coming and cling to His Word.
- 5. In these times, put your hope in the LORD and call others to do the same.
