## No King but Jesus

Jesus is our warrior King. The ominous fact that He destroys all of His and our enemies is vividly portrayed in graphic detail that should rattle the very lives of those who find themselves on the "wrong side" of this kingdom conflict. On the other hand, those who have been subdued by the King of Glory can experience great assurance, comfort and confidence, not matter what comes to pass because they are in the constant care and protection of the one Whose name is Faithful and True!
