## Explanation :

Dan 9:26 After 69 weeks (i.e. 483 years), shall Messiah be cut off fulfillment : His crucifixion.

and the people (hx: the Romans) ... shall destroy the city near-term fulfillment : 70 AD Jerusalem was destroyed by General Titus under the orders of Emperor Vespasian. far-term fulfillment : when the antichrist (*the prince that shall come*) ushers in *the end* (described in verse 27).

The Great Parenthesis : A 'Gap' occurs between v 26 and v 27.

Remember, the first 69 weeks had already run their course with the 'the Triumphal Entry' of Christ into Jerusalem.

Jesus was asked about the 70th week in Matthew 24:3 after his triumphal entry in had occurred in Matthew chapter 21.

So his prophecy in Matthew (chapters 24-25, i.e. 'the Olivet Discourse') and John's Revelation (chapters 6-18) describe the 70th week which would not appear until *the fulness of the Gentiles be come in*, Romans 11:25.

The 'Gap' between the 69th and 70th week comprise 'the Church age' (approximately 2,000 years long) when mostly *Gentiles* come into the true Church of Jesus Christ. After this time period . . . all Israel shall be saved, Romans 11:26, when . . . the Deliverer turns away ungodliness from Jacob . . . as the Jews go through the period known as ... the time of Jacob's trouble, Jeremiah 30:7.

The "Christian Church" comes between the crucifixion and the Rapture which occurs just prior to the revealing of the *prince that shall come* (i.e. the antichrist, v26-27). The Church has no place in the prophecy concerning *Daniel's people and city*, Daniel 9:24.

The 'Church Age" is the **Gap** or **Parenthesis** between the 69th and 70th week. The full seven year long 70th week is described in the above chart.
