PROVOKING CHILDREN (BY NOT PROVOKING)

The Family Series

TEXT: Ephesians 6:4 And, ye fathers, provoke not your children to wrath: but bring them up in the nurture and admonition of the Lord.

Provoke:

"To call into action; to arouse; to excite...To make angry; to offend..." (Webster's, 1828)

1 Samuel 1:6 And her adversary also **provoked her sore**, for to make her fret, because the LORD had shut up her womb.

1 Chronicles 21:1 And Satan stood up against Israel, and provoked David to number Israel.

1 Kings 16:2...and hast made my people Israel to sin, to provoke me to anger with their sins;

Galatians 5:26 Let us not be desirous of vain glory, provoking one another...

Hebrews 12:9 Furthermore we have had fathers of our flesh which corrected us, and we gave them reverence: shall we not much rather be in subjection unto the Father of spirits, and live?

"When I had children to bring up, they so far inherited my nature, that they deserved to be whipped often; and they got their deserts! It was true I would rather have taken five blows than to have given one; and yet I put it on to them. And I remembered the precept, 'What your hand finds to do, do it with your might.'" (Henry Ward Beecher)

Proverbs 14:12 There is a way which **seemeth right** unto a man, but the end thereof are the ways **of death.**

Proverbs 23:13 Withhold not correction from the child: for if thou beatest him with the rod, he shall not die.

14 Thou shalt beat him with the rod, and shalt deliver his soul **from hell.**

Proverbs 19:18 Chasten thy son while there is hope, and **let not thy soul spare** for his crying.

Proverbs 13:24 He that spareth his rod hateth his son: but he that loveth him chasteneth him betimes.

Hebrews 12:10 For they verily for a few days chastened us **after their own pleasure**; but he for our profit, that we might be partakers of his holiness.

Psalms 119:67 Before I was afflicted I went astray: but now have I kept thy word.

"How often we may be moved more by the disturbance of our own comfort than by the sense of our child's need of correction!" (Ironside, *Proverbs*)

Hebrews 10:24 And let us consider one another **to provoke** unto love and to good works:

1 Corinthians 13:5...is not easily provoked...

Many children act like they are sinfully provoked, when they are simply being provoked in a holy way by holy parents.

Hebrews 12:11 Now no chastening for the present seemeth to be joyous, but grievous...

Proverbs 9:8...rebuke a wise man, and **he will love thee**.

Proverbs 13:18...he that regardeth reproof shall be honoured.

Psalms 141:5 Let the righteous smite me; it shall be a kindness: and let him reprove me; it shall be an excellent oil, which shall not break my head...

Proverbs 6:23 For the commandment is a lamp; and the law is light; and reproofs of instruction are the way of life:

Proverbs 9:9 Give instruction to a **wise** man, and he will be yet wiser: teach a just man, and he will increase in learning.

Proverbs 29:15 The rod and reproof give wisdom: but a child left to himself bringeth his mother to shame.

Proverbs 15:12 A scorner loveth not one that reproveth him: neither will he go unto the wise.
