 - B. IF I'M HONEST, MY EXPECTATION IN LIFE IS THAT WHEN I'M HAPPY AND COMFORTABLE, GOD WILL KEEP THINGS THAT WAY. WHEN THINGS ARE CHALLENGING, THAT GOD WILL CHANGE IT FOR THE BETTER. MY EXPECTATION IS THAT THE BIG CHANGES IN LIFE WILL ONLY BE FOR A BETTER LIFE NOW.

WORLDVIEW DRIVES HOW YOU INTERPRET THOSE FACTS. LIKE WEARING A PAIR OF SUNGLASSES. THE COLOR OF THE GLASSES AFFECTS HOW YOU INTERPRET WHAT YOU'RE SEEING.
