Ecclesiastes 5:8 - 6:12

- I. THE VALUE OF WORLDLY SUCCESS ()—What makes you a success in the sight of the world?
 - **A. Riches** (1 Kg 3:13)
 - 1. Respect/Admiration (Ps 49:18; Pr 14:20)
 - 2. <u>Safety/Security</u> (Job 31:24; Pr 18:11)
 - 3. <u>Influence/Control</u> (Pr 22:7)
 - **B.** Long Life (6:6; 1 Kg 3:14; Ps 91:16;)—time to enjoy
 - C. Many Children (6:3)
 - 1. Practical
 - Labor—need people to work the farm and home
 - Protection—strength in numbers
 - Future Provision—someone to take care of you in old age
 - 2. Prestige
 - Virility (manly prowess)
 - **Influence** in society
 - Legacy (memory, future influence of culture)
 - **D.** Good Burial (6:3b; Isa 53:9)—the last impression you make
- II. THE VANITY OF WEALTH It is empty; it can't do what you think
 - A. It won't satisfy (5:10)—never enough
 - B. Other people take it (5:11; Mt 6:19)—children, slaves, freeloaders
 - C. It can hurt you (5:13; Dt 8:13-14; Pr 28:20; Mk 4:19; 10:24; 1 Tim 6:9-10; Rev 3:17)
 - 1. More ways to die
 - 2. Makes you a target
 - 3. Corrupts your character
 - 4. Controls you.
 - **D.** <u>It can be lost</u> in this life (5:14; Pr 23:5; Mat 6:19)

- E. You cant' take it with you when you die (5:15-16; Ps 49:10-12, 16-19; Lk 12:20).
- F. It causes worry (Mt 13:22)—making it, maintaining it, protecting it
 - 1. Physical toll (5:12, 17)—insomnia, indigestion
 - 2. Emotional toll (5:17)—anxiety, anger, bitterness
- III. <u>THE PROBLEM OF GREED</u> ()—a problem for **everyone**, not just rich
 - A. A Mindset of Materialism
 - B. A Lack of Charity (Mat 22:39)
 - **C.** An Indication of Idolatry (Mat 6:24, 31-32; Col 3:5; 1 Tim 6:10)
 - 1. Worshipping Wealth—valuing the gift above the Giver
 - 2. Scorning Providence—discontent with the provision of God
 - 3. Serving Self—trying to BE God
- IV. THE ABILITY TO ENJOY (5:18-20; 6:1-9; 1 Tim 6:6)—godliness with contentment
 - **A.** <u>Life is a gift from God</u>. (Ps 100:3; 139:13-16; Job 33:4)
 - **B.** <u>This is my portion</u>. (Mat 6:31-32; Ps 47:4; Lam 3:22-23; Heb 13:5-6)—God has chosen this for me
 - 1. My inheritance
 - 2. My work
 - 3. My daily bread
 - C. Gratitude produces joy. (1 Tim 6:6-10; Js 1:17)
 - 1. God owes me nothing.
 - 2. God gives me good things—everything I need.
 - 3. God is good to me!
