**- And The “Beginning Of Sorrows / Birth-Pangs”**

**- General Tribulation Before The Great Tribulation**

**- “The sequence of events that Jon describes once Jesus takes the scroll and begins to open its seals closely parallels the sequence of events Jesus prophesied in Matthew 24. Revelation 6 and Matthew 24 are complementary presentations of world history between the first and second comings of Christ.” (James Hamilton)**
