Isaiah 61:1-4, 10-11 (620) "Evangel Preaching" 3 of 5

The Robe was one of the best-selling Biblical novels of the 1940s. The book (later a motion picture) presented a speculative tale about the soldier who won Jesus' robe through a dice game. Today Isaiah presents to us another kind of tale and another kind of clothing – referred to here as "the robe of righteousness" (v 10c). Consider the present condition of your own "spiritual clothing" and quickly put on the wondrous "garments of salvation" (v 10b).
