True Conversion

I. A Radical Turning

- A. True conversion is radical turning from living unto self to living unto Christ. (Ez. 33; Col. 3)

- B. True conversion is the work of God in us so that we are learning in whatever we do in word or deed to do all in the name of the Lord (vs. 17).

II. A Constant Battle

- A. This constant battle is responding radically to sin in my life by a continuous putting off of the old man of sin.

- B. Putting on the new man is the constant endeavor to place yourself and your whole life under the rule of the new man. It is seeking to live out of Christ's life.

III. A Divine Work

- A. When God works true conversion in us, we produce fruit.

- B. Such a changed life is God's work.
