- 1. Read **Luke 6:37-42**. What do most non-Christians (along with an increasing number of Christians) usually mean when they quote v.37 by itself? How should the instructions in the following verses (especially vv.41-42) prevent people from overstating the intended meaning of v.37?
- 2. Read **1 Corinthians 6:1-4**. How does this passage motivate you to learn to discerningly identify and respond to right and wrong?
- 3. Read Romans 2:1-5. Why is it so easy for everyone to engage in this kind of double-standard?
- 4. Read **Ephesians 4:31 5:2**. How are the problems found in v.31 expressed and specifically demonstrated in your life and relationships? Why does 5:1-2 necessarily change all that?
- 5. Read **Psalm 32**. Describe the kind of exhortation in vv.6-11 that flows from the perspective of vv.1-5. How does this compare to the kind of exhortation we might imagine would come from one who is not mindful of his own forgiveness?
