**Haggai 2:15-19**

**I. Doctrine: God's overt Mercies are Not *Necessarily* \_\_\_\_\_  
To the Initial Time of Covenantal Obedience**

A. –This is Uniformly \_\_\_\_\_—even with the Sacra-  
ments; . . . , (Ps. 46:2-5)

B. . . . But this should *Not* \_\_\_\_\_ us From *Pur-*  
*suing* Christ (now), (Isa. 55:6)

**III. How we May Better \_\_\_\_\_ With God's Sove-  
reign Timing**

A. –By Being *More* \_\_\_\_\_ on *our* Faithfulness, *Than*  
on “Good” Results, (Hab. 3:17-18)

B. –By Being \_\_\_\_\_ that our Generous Heavenly  
Father will *Not* Be “Outdone,” (Matt. 7:1)

**Key Phrase**—v. 19c: “. . . *But from this day on I will bless you.*” (ESV)
