Being Bold for Christ Acts 4:1-31

Main Point:

Even though you may be opposed by others, you must remain faithful to Jesus as His witness; therefore, pray for God to embolden you by His Holy Spirit.

1. There will always be those who oppose the gospel of Jesus Christ.

2. But you must not let it keep you from being faithful to your Savior as His witness.

3. This is especially true when you experience pressure from your opponents.

4. Therefore, you need to pray for God to embolden you by His Holy Spirit.
