Application Questions

These questions are provided for your further study and application of today's sermon. Thoughtfully writing out the answers to these questions will help to drive home the point of today's study. It is also helpful when you are able to discuss your answers with others.

- 1. Read **2 Corinthians 5:17-18**. Describe the circumstances surrounding the time when God "reconciled you to himself" and you were placed "in Christ" and became a "new creation."
- 2. Read **Psalm 51:1-5** and **Isaiah 1:18**. Why is a clarified sense of our sin and guilt before our Maker so important to understanding the profound relief of cleansing and forgiveness before a holy God?
- 3. Read **Colossians 1:12-14** and **Titus 3:4-7**. Why are "pouring" and "washing" in Titus 3 such helpful metaphors for the feelings and experience of being fully forgiven and qualified for "the inheritance of the saints"?
- 4. Read **Hebrews 4:15** and **Matthew 3:13-15**. Why is the fact that Jesus continued to "fulfill all righteousness" by submitting to the water baptism of John a helpful reminder of the role of water baptism in a life that pleases the Father?
- 5. Read **Matthew 28:18-20**. What would you say to someone who says they don't plan to be baptized in water because Jesus already fulfilled all the righteous acts God wants us to do, and has imputed them to us?
