- What is your answer to Paul's question in 32? Now state your answer in the form of a statement.
- Community Group Focus Question: What is the overall impact of these two verses on the Christian; i.e., what was Paul communicating to his readers and how should this inform your life?
- For our 2014 Journals: How do these verses help us know and follow Jesus?
