"Sardis: The Dead Church" Revelation 3:1-6

Revelation #8

The risen and exalted Christ ministers to His church at Sardis.

1. Jesus' Declaration

v. 1

- (1) How Jesus Presents Himself "These things says He who has the seven Spirits of God and the seven stars"
 - Significance: Directly related to Jesus' admonition

and His warning of judgment (vv. 2-3)

- Meaning: Jesus is the One in whom there is fullness of life!

He is the only source of life.

His church has life and light and power only in Him. cf. 1:4, 12, 20; 4:5

Jesus is the sovereign King over His church; He does with her as He will.

(2) Jesus Knows all about this church!

"I know your works,

that you have a name that you are alive,

-1- They had a reputation for being a viable church

but you are dead."

- -2- They are in fact dead!
 - But they have not ceased to be a church in Jesus' eyes
 - There are still some true believers in their midst

2. Jesus' Admonition

vv. 2-4

- (1) His Counsel and Warning to the Whole Church (2-3)
 - -1- "Be watchful"
 - "Wake up!" (ESV)
 - They had failed in this and the enemy had taken advantage!
 - -2- "Strengthen the things which remain, that are ready to die"
 - Things were in an entirely weakened state
 - Their works were presently incomplete left undone. "I have found

no works of yours complete"

- -3- "Remember how you have received and heard"
 - "What you have received" (that deposit of truth)
 - "...and what you heard" (their original hearing of the gospel)

-4- "Hold fast and repent"

-5- "if you will not watch, I will come upon you as a thief..."

"and you will not know" (strong double negative)

(2) His Commendation of a Very Few (4)

"You have a few names even in Sardis who have not defiled their garments; and they shall walk with Me in white, for they are worthy."

3. Jesus' Promise vv. 5-6

(1) The Promise

"He who overcomes shall be clothed in white garments, and I will not blot out his name from the Book of Life

- -1- The Condition: "He who overcomes" but I will confess his name before My Father and before His angels."
 - Characteristic of all true saints
 - Descriptive of the character of the Christian life
- -2- The Reward:
 - Perfect purity in the age to come! "He...shall be clothed in white garments"
 - Assured security in the favor of God! "I will not blot out his name from the Book of Life"
 - An implied warning to those with an empty profession of faith!
 - "I will not blot out" (strong double negative) "No way will I ever blot out!"
 - Jesus' open acknowledgment before all of heaven! "I will confess his name before My Father and before His angels."
- (2) The Call to Hear "He who has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says to the churches."
 - The admonition is to be received by all
