

 - o These 7 congregations represent the whole church of Christ in every age

The Greeting

- Grace
 - Fundamental to becoming who we are
- Peace: flows from our grace-based relationship with God
 - o Peace is the reflection of the smile of God in the heart of the believer who has been reconciled to God through Jesus Christ, is the result of grace. (William Hendriksen)
